Home Care

(For those recovering from an acute illness needing skilled rehabilitation)

- Skilled nursing services
- Physical, occupational, speech and swallowing therapies
- Social work services
- Home health aides
- Telehealth program
- Pediatric Home Care
- Diabetes and Nutrition Education
- Advanced Wound Care and Ostomy Care management
- Visiting Volunteers
- IV therapy
- Available in private homes, assisted living and residential care facilities
- Educational services, Support Groups

Hospice

(For those with a terminal illness with a prognosis of 6 months or less and no longer receiving active treatment)

- Medical care supervised by patient's attending physician and Hospice Medical Director
- Registered Nurses trained/certified in hospice
- Social workers trained/skilled in hospice
- PT/OT/ST as needed
- Home health aides/Homemakers
- Hospice Volunteers
- Respite care, Inpatient Care, Continuous Care
- Bereavement and spiritual counseling
- Complementary Care program
- Available in Nursing facilities, including Nursing Homes, Assisted Living, Group and Boarding Homes
- Focus of care is on comfort, quality of remaining life, life closure, and peaceful death.

Palliative Care Services

(For those with a life-threatening or advanced illness still receiving active treatment to prolong life)

- Palliative Care Home Care Program offers same services and has same regulatory requirements as traditional Home Care
- Registered Nurses and Social Workers are specially trained/skilled in Palliative Care
- Palliative Care Home Care Program available in private home and residential care settings
- Consulting services by Palliative Care Medical Director available in any setting (hospital, nursing home, private home, residential care) and covered under Medicare Part B
- Focus of care is on pain and symptom management, treatment options, goals of treatment, and care planning for continued health care needs

In-Network Insurances: Anthem of Maine, Medicare/MaineCare, EBPA, Martin's Point

Other Insurances: Negotiated on a case-by-case basis
